

# Economic Impact of Disability Waivers

## Total Number of FY 2007 State and Federal Dollars Paid for the Developmental Disability, CADI, TBI and CAC Waivers

More than 75 percent of these dollars go to caregiver compensation. Because caregivers are modestly paid, they spend almost all of their money locally on goods and services, supporting local businesses and the local economy.

ARRM members employ more than 27,000 caregivers. Other providers employ thousands more. The disability provider industry is often among the largest employers and job providers in many Minnesota communities.
